The History of Layritz Park

Richard Layritz was born on April 27, 1867, in Ernstthal near Dresden in Germany, the youngest of eight children. Richard first moved to Kelowna and managed a nursery over the winter of 1886/87. In the spring of 1887, he decided to move to Victoria, thinking that with the mild climate he could grow all year round. Unfortunately, he guessed wrong—his entire stock was frozen during the winter of 1887/88 and he lost both his business and his property.


In 1898, Richard went to the Klondike to earn more money. By 1900 he had raised enough money so that he could come to Saanich and get his nursery going. He bought 14 acres on Wilkinson Road just north of the jail and later increased his property holdings to 99 acres. In 1906 Richard returned to Germany and married his wife Eliese. Tragically, Eliese died in Saanich on October 4, 1916. Three years later, Richard married his second wife, an English girl 14 years his junior.

Richard gradually expanded his nursery holdings to two 10-acre plots of land in Gordon Head. One plot was at Ash and Barry, where he had a summer house and grew orchard seedlings. The second property was closer to Mount Douglas and both acreages had sea frontage.

In 1953 Richard Layritz donated 15½ acres to the Municipality of Saanich with the stipulation that they be fenced in and used as a park for children. The original plaque was erected in 1963 and the road once called Sandra Lane was renamed Layritz Avenue. A new plaque was placed in 1995 on a rock near the park buildings.

Since Layritz Nurseries Ltd. was the only major nursery in British Columbia in the early days, most of the trees and shrubs on Victoria city streets and parks came from Richard's nursery. Richard died on September 10, 1954, and his ashes were placed, at his request, beneath a Redwood tree on Wilkinson Road near his house.

GAMES LOCATION

All games will be played on the Major Baseball diamond, located near the concession.

PRACTICE FIELDS/BATTING CAGE

A dual batting cage will be made available to teams as well as two on-site diamonds for warm-up before the games as well as practices while other teams play.

OTHER PARK AMENITIES

The clubhouse is located above the concession, behind home plate. Washroom facilities are located past centerfield on the Major Baseball diamond. A full concession will be available, and there is a new playground to keep our younger fans happy.

PARKING

- There will be one reserved parking spot for each team for the entire tournament to be used at your discretion. This will be clearly marked in the first row of parking. This will be your spot for the duration of the tournament so come and go to the park as you wish.
- Please also honour the other marked, reserved parking spots for our volunteers, including umpires and the district administrator.
- Please do not drive your vehicles on the service road or park near the diamonds or batting cage without prior approval. These areas are meant for Saanich staff and commercial service vehicles only.
- Please respect the residential parking signs along Layritz Ave.; we want to be a good neighbour to residents in the area.

OPENING CEREMONIES


Opening ceremonies will occur on Thursday, August 1st at 5:30PM. **All teams are required to attend.**
